- 1 The Court will allow the parties to litigate all claims and allegations in this case in due course pursuant to the usual timeframes allowed by Alaska's Rules of Civil Procedure, including but not limited to Conrad's claims and allegations regarding the Board seats of Theresa Woody, Rhonda VanZandt, and Tanya Tito:
- 2. The stewardship role of Lisa Conrad established by the Court on June 23. 2015, remains restricted as set forth at that hearing, meaning she has no authority to expend funds or take action on behalf of the corporation except as absolutely necessary to meet the normal ongoing needs of the Corporation. Approval for any unusual expenses or other actions must be sought by motion to the Court.
- 3. Conrad must submit a report of expenses and actions taken on behalf of the Corporation on the first day of each month. If that day is a weekend, she may file the report on the next regular business day.
- 4. Given Conrad's direct adversity to the Corporation in this litigation, she is not a steward for the TCUC with respect to this lawsuit.
- 5. The purported Board allegedly elected on July 9, 2015 is not authorized to act on behalf of the Corporation unless and until a final judgment providing for such authorization is issued this case.
